## ***EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES***

***Please check daily schedules for times and locations.***

### **Amusement Park Tours:**

Tour major Park attractions, while learning its history and obtaining insights from a Park team member. Preregistration required.

### **Fisheries and Aquaculture:**

Discover the impact fisheries and marine renewal have in our province.

### **Fit Lifestyle:**

Staff of the Fundy YMCA will share the importance of health and fitness in our daily lives.

### **Ground Search and Rescue:**

Representatives will be on hand to educate us about the work they do, including locating lost persons.

## ***WHAT TO EXPECT***

### **Registration:**

- You can register at [www.upperclements.com](http://www.upperclements.com), email [marketing@upperclements.com](mailto:marketing@upperclements.com), telephone toll free at 1-888-248-4567, or print and fax the registration form to 902-532-7681. The registration form can be found in the School Days link on our website and on the last page of this package.
- If possible, book a rain date. Due to the unpredictable nature of our region's weather, it is advisable to have a backup plan.
- Park staff will contact you to confirm your registration information prior to your arrival. If you are not contacted by the week before your arrival, please call us to confirm your registration.

### **Arrival:**

- Your bus will be queued in line in the parking lot.
- Your class representative will be greeted by a Park team member to identify your school, provide information updates and answer any questions you may have.
- The representative will go to Guest Services to pay, while students proceed inside to be measured and receive their bracelets. Maps and activity information are available at Guest Services. If several schools arrive at the same time, students will wait outside until advised by a Park team member to go inside.
- Your bus will be asked to remain stationary until Park Security signals the driver that it is safe to proceed. Buses are welcome to park on the far side of the parking lot for the day or leave and return to pick up students.
- Please note that automobiles will be directed to the right side entering the parking lot and buses will be directed to the left side entering the parking lot.

### **Park Closure:**

- During School Days, any decision to not open due to inclement weather will be made by 8:00 am.
- Park closures are also posted on our facebook page.
- If you are concerned about the weather forecast, we welcome you to change your date of registration at any time by telephoning 1-888-248-4567.



## ***WHAT TO EXPECT***

### **Activities:**

- Activity information, schedules and maps are available in the Guest Services Building and on our website.
- Activity worksheets are available at Guest Services.
- Preregistration is required for Park Tours and band performances.

### **Food Services:**

- There are numerous meal selections available throughout the Park and many cost less than \$5 (not including beverages or hst).
